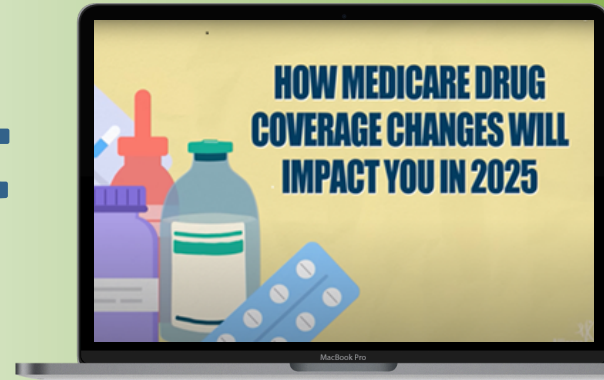


Open Enrollment 2025

October 15 - December 7, 2024



A new film released this month from the **Alliance for Aging Research** details upcoming cost-saving changes to Medicare Part D plans and what beneficiaries need to do to take advantage of these options. The film, **How Medicare Drug Coverage Changes Will Impact You in 2025** explains how to decrease out-of-pocket costs for prescriptions.

In 2025, Medicare Part D beneficiaries will have two options:

- An annual out-of-pocket maximum of \$2,000.
- Additionally, the new Medicare Prescription Payment Plan will allow beneficiaries to spread out their costs through interest-free monthly installments, helping older adults budget and avoid the financial strain of paying for expensive medications upfront.

The out-of-pocket maximum is automatic, and you don't need to do anything to take advantage of this important new benefit. However, beneficiaries that would like to participate in the new Prescription Payment Plan must sign up with their Part D plan.*

**Beneficiaries can sign-up at any time throughout the year, but must re-enroll each year.*
